

## **Announcing Enterprise Bank's Recognition in the Boston Globe 100's Top Places to Work '08**

According to the Boston Globe 100's Top Places to Work '08 magazine supplement that published in the **November 9, 2008 edition of the Boston Globe**, over 600 companies were invited to participate in the "Top Places to Work" employee survey, of which 293 companies actually participated. The following is a summary of Enterprise Bank's overall ranking in certain categories.

- **Enterprise Bank was listed #18 of all companies (out of 293 participants).**
- **Enterprise Bank ranked #6 on the list of all midsize companies.**
- **In the top 10 list for four success categories- diversity, flexibility, careers and ethics, Enterprise Bank was listed as #7 ( out of 293 participants) in the ethics category.**
- **At #18, we are the top ranked bank on the list. Only two other banks were recognized in the top 100, a community bank (small workplace) was ranked #49 and a commercial and retail bank (large workplace) was listed as #77.**
